Board Policy No. 5000: NONDISCRIMINATION

It is the policy of the District to provide to every person equal opportunity to receive an education as required by federal and/or state law. The District shall not illegally discriminate against a pupil because of the pupil's race, sex, color, creed, disability, national origin or ancestry, or sexual preference. The District is committed to the law of equal educational opportunity. No teacher shall give any instruction, nor shall there be any activity which reflects adversely upon persons because of their race, sex, color, creed, disability, national origin, ancestry, or sexual preference. No textbook or other instructional materials shall be used which contain any matter reflecting adversely upon persons because of their race, sex, color, creed, disability, national origin, ancestry or sexual preference. The Superintendent is designated as the Equal Educational Opportunity/Title IX management employee directly responsible for coordinating efforts to ensure compliance with all non-discrimination laws. The Superintendent may designate another administrator to be directly responsible.
