

**WESTMORLAND UNION ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT**

**Board Policy No. 5032:      PUPILS WITH ALCOHOL OR DRUG RELATED DISABILITIES**

- A.      The Board recognizes that, unfortunately, some pupils may have alcohol or drug related disabilities despite all the efforts that are made by parents, the schools, and the community to prevent pupils from using illegal drugs or alcohol.
- B.      It is the District's policy not to discriminate against a pupil who has an alcohol or drug related disability, who seeks to participate in treatment, or who actually participates in such treatment. However, the District strictly prohibits any pupil from:
1.      Unlawfully possessing, using, selling, or otherwise furnishing, or being under the influence of, any controlled substance (listed in Health And Safety Code sections 11053, *et seq.*), any alcoholic beverage, or an intoxicant of any kind.
  2.      Unlawfully offering, arranging, or negotiating to sell any controlled substance (listed in Health And Safety Code section 11053, *et seq.*), an alcoholic beverage, or an intoxicant of any kind, and then either selling, delivering, or otherwise furnishing to any person another liquid, substance, or material and representing the liquid, substance, or material as a controlled substance, alcoholic beverage, or intoxicant.
- C.      A pupil may be suspended or expelled for any act identified in paragraph B above related to school activity or attendance which occurs at any time, including, but not limited to, any of the following:
1.              While on school grounds.
  2.              While going to or coming from school.
  3.              During the lunch period, whether on or off the campus.
  4.              During, or while going or coming from, a school sponsored activity.
